

# Criteria for an Ontario Roofing Contractor to become an OIRCA Active Member

- 1. Applicants will have been engaged in the operation of a successful roofing and related sheet metal business in the Industrial, Commercial, Institutional (ICI) construction sector for a period of at least 5 years and with their place of business in the Province of Ontario. Applicants will submit a copy of the company's Articles of Incorporation verifying that they are an Ontario Corporation as defined by the Ontario Business Corporation Act and provide a list of all officers, directors and major shareholders substantiated in writing by the applicant's lawyer.
- 2. Applicants will have a permanent and actively operating sheet metal shop on their premises, which must contain, at a minimum, the following equipment:
  - a brake, consisting of a minimum of 8 feet in length and capable of forming up to 18-gauge metal;
  - a shear/slitter capable of cutting 22-gauge metal;
  - a layout bench; and
  - sufficient inventory of metal suitable for application on ICI projects;

and permit OIRCA representatives to visit and inspect the applicant's Premises to determine that the company is operating out of a convention office/shop/yard type facility.

- 3. Applicants will have minimum annual ICI roofing revenue of \$5MM for applicants in the Greater Toronto Area (GTA) and \$2.5MM for applicants outside the Ontario GTA for the past 5 calendar years. This requirement to be verified in writing by the applicant's accountant. OIRCA Members cannot subcontract more than 15% of annual ICI revenue to non-OIRCA members and applicants agree to abide by this requirement should they be successful in securing membership in the Association
- 4. Applicants will submit company financial statement (minimum statement: notice to reader) for the past 5 fiscal years. Statements will be submitted to our third-party accountants for review (accountant information is included in this package).
- 5. Applicants will submit WSIB Premium Rate Extended statements and where applicable CAD-7 reports for the past 5 calendar years.
- 6. Applicants will submit a formal application (attached) with a cheque in the amount of \$8,500.00 (plus HST), payable to the OIRCA, which will be considered the applicant's **Application Fee**. When accepted as an Active Member, annual dues of \$3,937.00 (plus HST) will be assessed.

**Unionized contractors** will pay Industry Fund dues of \$0.07 per man hour worked to cover the OIRCA Labour Relations Section operation and Ontario Construction Secretariat fees.

Companies with branch offices will be required to pay a Branch Membership Fee equal to 50% of the Active Membership Fee, for each satellite location.

7. Applicants will submit a cheque for \$12,000 (plus HST) payable to OIRCA, which represents an up-front **Inspection Fee** to cover "third party" in-progress (workmanship and safety) and completed project inspections. The applicant will be required to submit, on a monthly basis, a list of roofing projects, with a minimum roof area of 5,000 sq. ft., including the following information: project name, location, size, new or reroof, type of system being installed, detailed scope of work, anticipated start and completion dates as well as the client's jobsite contact with telephone number. **Sub-contracted projects will not be eligible.** 

Applicants will prove compliance with OIRCA and industry standards as well as proficiency in all three generic types of low-slope roofing systems: BUR-hot or cold, single-ply and modified bitumen.

- 8. Applicants will complete the attached **ROOFING CONTRACTOR'S QUALIFICATION FORM** and **include** requested documentation.
- 9. Applicants will submit two (2) letters of recommendation addressed to the Corporation from each of the following: building owners, general contractors, and roofing consultants/ engineers/architects. The letters will describe the work performed by the applicant and attest to the satisfactory performance of such work by the applicant. Each letter shall refer to a different project, all of which must have been completed within the 5-year period preceding the date of the applicant's application.
- 10. The applicant will submit to an independent "third party" Safety Evaluation to confirm the company's compliance with the Occupational Health & Safety Act and Construction Regulations.

All applicants are encouraged to review their present Health and Safety Program to ensure compliance with industry standards prior to applying for membership. To assist you with determining whether your company's program meets OIRCA's minimum standards we encourage you to contact IHSA directly to have one of their Health and Safety Consultants review your current program. An inadequate safety program is the single biggest reason for applicant rejection. The applicant's written Policy/Program will meet a minimum passing score of 80%.

#### There will be zero tolerance for safety infractions relating to fall protection.

- 11. Applicants will comply with both the OIRCA Competition Law Guidance and Guidelines Governing OIRCA Meetings by signing and submitting the OIRCA Undertaking to Comply.
- 12. The applicant will attend an "orientation" meeting at the OIRCA office. This meeting will take place following OIRCA's receipt of the completed application package, all payments owing at the time of application and notification that the applicant has received a passing grade on their Health and Safety policy. The purpose of this meeting is to establish awareness with the applicant as to exactly what is expected from them during the evaluation process.
- 13. It is understood that where a company has applied for Active Membership and they are moving forward within the application process, they refrain from the bidding on any roofing project (new construction or reroofing) that specifies **only OIRCA members qualify to bid on this project.**

- 14. The principals of the applicant company will acknowledge and agree not to pursue legal action against the OIRCA, its staff or any of its members, in the event the application for Active Membership is denied. In addition, the applicant will accept that third party representatives including legal counsel are not permitted to participate in the process related to their application, including any meetings or communication between the OIRCA, the Board, the Membership Committee, and the Association's representatives or staff.
- 15. After the OIRCA Board of Directors approves the membership application, a twenty-four (24) month Probationary Period must be served.

During this twenty-four (24) month Probationary Period, a continual inspection process of the contractor's roofing projects in progress will take place. The applicant must register in advance, on a monthly basis, with the OIRCA office, all projects that they will be doing in the future which are of five thousand (5,000) square feet or more in size. Sub-contracted projects will not be eligible.

A Probationary Period Inspection fee of \$7,500 + HST must be submitted to cover the inspection charges that will be incurred during this probationary period. During the probationary period full OIRCA dues must be paid.

If, during the twenty-four (24) month Probationary Period the inspections carried out reveal a serious violation of good roofing practices or a written complaint regarding the New Probationary Active Member is received by the Corporation, the Corporation's Membership Committee will appoint a committee to investigate.

The OIRCA Board of Directors may terminate the New Probationary Active Member's membership in the Association if the violations or complaints are justified and remain unresolved.

- 16. Active Members of OIRCA must also become members of the Canadian Roofing Contractors Association (CRCA). CRCA will not consider an application for membership until an application for OIRCA Active Membership is approved. At the time of submitting the OIRCA membership application, an application for CRCA membership must also be included. When the OIRCA application is accepted, OIRCA will then forward the CRCA membership application to CRCA for processing.
- 17. If an applicant's application for Active Membership is denied, the applicant will be entitled to an Appeal Meeting with the OIRCA Appeal Committee.

Should the appeal be unsuccessful, the Applicant may reapply two years following the date that its application was denied; five years if the applicant has been denied twice or more.
